Households by Income

Current median household income is \$51,169 in the market area, compared to \$51,546 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$61,314 in five years. In 2000, median household income was \$40,891, compared to \$30,282 in 1990.

Current average household income is \$78,532 in the market area, compared to \$71,092 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$97,297 in five years. In 2000, median household income was \$61,524, compared to \$42,061 in 1990.

Current per capita income is \$32,393 in the market area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$27,084. The per capita income is projected to be \$40,059 in five years. In 2000, the per capita income was \$25,256, compared to \$16,620 in 1990.

Populated by Employment

Currently 92.9% of the civilian labor force in the identified market area is employed and 7.1% are unemployed. In comparison, 93.4% of the U.S. civilian labor force is employed, and 6.6% are unemployed. In five years the rate of employment in the market area will be 93.0% of the civilian labor force, and unemployment will be 7.0%. The percentage of the U.S. civilian labor force that will be employed in five years is 93.8%, and 6.2% will be unemployed. In 2000, 67.2% of the population aged 16 years or older in the market area participated in the labor force, and .4% were in the Armed Forces.

In the current year, the occupational distribution of the employed population is;

- 70.85 in white collar jobs (compared to 60.5% of U.S. employment)
- 15.3% in service jobs (compared to 16.4% of U.S. employment)
- 13.8% in blue collar jobs (compared to 23.1% of U.S. employment)

In 2000, 82.2% of the market area population drove alone to work, and 1.7% worked at home. The average travel time to work in 2000 was 19.7 minutes in the market area, compared to the U.S. average of 25.5 minutes.

Population by Education

In 2000, the educational attainment of the population aged 25 years or older in the market area was distributed as follows:

- 11.2% had not earned a high school diploma (19.6% in the U.S.)
- 18.9% were high school graduates only (28.6% in the U.S.)
- 4.0% had completed an Associate degree (6.3% in the U.S.)
- 24.2% had a Bachelor's degree (15.5% in the U.S.)
- 23.1% had earned a Master's/Professional/Doctorate Degree (8.95 in the U.S)
